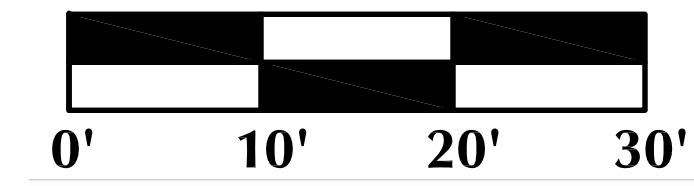
Why support us?

FENCE DESIGN (DRC Submittal 4/19/2012):

1. A new 5' tall fence is proposed on the north and east edges of the garden. The existing fence along the south and western edges is proposed to remain. New fence length is approx. 240 lineal feet.
2. The proposed horizontal alignment is the same as the existing construction fence, leaving ample space between road and parking on the outside of the garden and the proposed fence.
3. 6"x6" wood posts, 6'-0" on center are proposed. Approximately (41) post are proposed. Wood will be pressure treated lumber (doug fir discussed).
4. (2) 2"x6" horizontal rails are proposed, one along the top at 5' height, the other lower, at 2' height.
5. A vinyl coated (black or green) welded wire mesh is proposed, with a mesh of approx. 2"x4". Proposed product is a 'YardGard' or 'FarmGard' suitable for proposed garden application.
6. Wood will be stained with a semi-transparent dark stain to coordinate with the EagleVail 'Grizzly Brown'.
